The Albrecht Free Clinic (AFC) provides medical care to individuals who are ill and have no insurance and limited resources. We are an independent non-profit organization that does not duplicate the services of any other county agencies. Patients are always treated with dignity and respect, and the highest levels of confidentiality are maintained.

Who Qualifies?*

You must meet the following eligibility criteria in order to receive services through the AFC:

- Washington County residency
- Household (HH) Income **no more than** 200% of Federal Poverty Limits
- Proof of BadgerCare application and outcome if HH income is 100% or less of FPL.
- Have no health insurance.

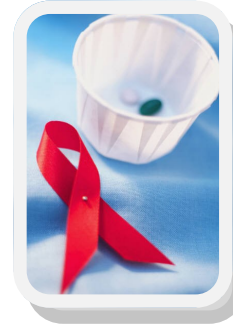

What type of medical services may I receive?

The AFC provides acute care services during our walk-in clinic times and chronic care services during our appointment time.

What medical services does the AFC not provide?

- Hospitalization
- Pregnancy testing
- STD testing
- School or work physicals
- Immunizations
- TB Testing



Do I have to pay for my medical services?

Healthcare services are free for patients who qualify as per our eligibility criteria but we strongly encourage a donation when you are able to do so.

How is the AFC supported?

The Albrecht Free Clinic would not be able to complete its mission without the guidance of the Board of Directors and the generous support of the community. While we have a small paid staff of employees, the strength of our organization is from an amazing group of 150+ volunteers. Included are non-medical clerical assistants, nurses, and providers who donate their time, skill, and expertise to provide care for those in need.
